

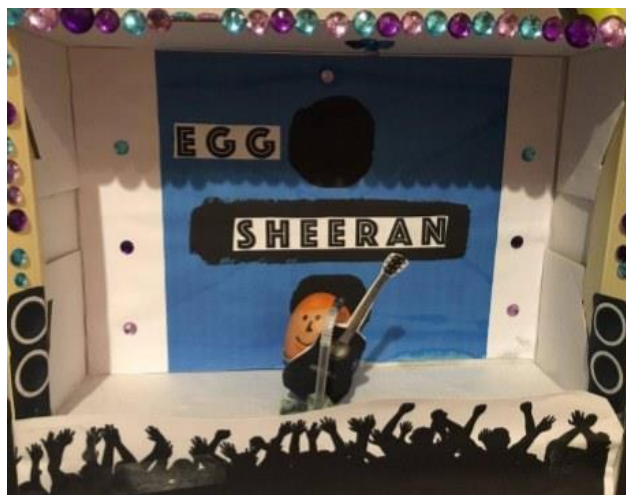
Junior Eggstravaganza - Thursday 26th March
