

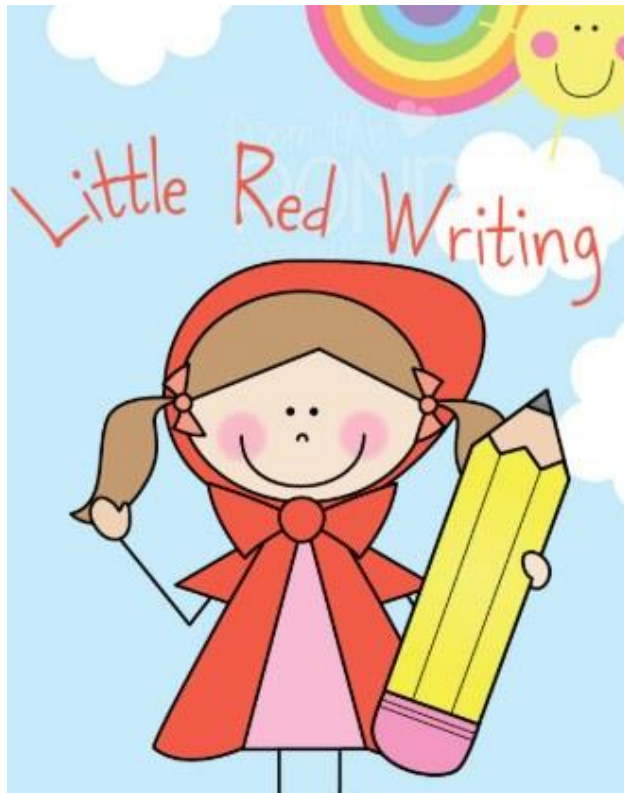

Learning Together Writing Workshops



We are very excited about our 'Learning Together Writing Workshops' happening for all year groups next week. You are warmly invited to join your child/ren for an interactive session that will focus upon how we develop writing skills at HPS. These workshops follow on from our Reading and Maths 'Learning Together' sessions for Y1-Y6 which have been really well attended and received - thank you.

Each session will start with a presentation to parents/carers to share how we teach writing at Harborne, with the introduction of our new scheme since October 2025. Our approach is evidence-led to develop writing skills with children and grow their love of the craft, in the most impactful ways. The children will then join us for workshops when you will have opportunity to work collaboratively with them.
