#### Early Birds are ready to Learn

Our doors open at 8.50am and any child arriving between 8.50am and 9.00am is "on time." Different classes have different morning routines but the time between 8.50am and 9.00am is never "dead time"... it may be used for reading, for skills practice or for some pupils to have a quick personal conference with the teacher about something they found difficult yesterday. Some classes start with a quick written "early work" task in books or on whiteboards. Others may use the interactive screen to share a song that helps practice number bonds, times tables, phonics or topic vocabulary. New learning will not start before 9.00am but these ten minutes are useful for reinforcement and revision. So please aim for 8.50am arrival so your child gets access to this extra 50 minutes every day of every week. As a well known supermarket says... "every little helps". It also makes it less likely that you will arrive after the 9am deadline and fall into the "late" category as even 9.01am means a late mark for your child on the register.

## Payment, registration and instrument selection

- Payment, registration, and instrument selection for lessons should be made via Parentpay. Payment will be required upfront. Fees for the Autumn Term will go onto ParentPay on Wed 22<sup>nd</sup> April. Fees for each term are £110.
- The deadline for payment will be <u>Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> June 12pm</u>. No payments or applications will be accepted beyond this date and time and refunds will be issued.
- Your payment of lessons confirms your acceptance of our Terms and Conditions and registration for lessons.
- When you have paid for lessons, your ParentPay receipt will secure and confirm your child's place.
- Lessons are available for children who will be in Year 2-6 in September 2024. (If your child is Pupil Premium, please contact Dawn Foley in the Main Site office before making any payments).
- Lessons will begin in the first two weeks in the Autumn Term. Further updates will be shared in September.

#### \*\*TERMS AND CONDITIONS- IMPORTANT PLEASE READ\*\*

-I understand that this is my only opportunity to sign my child up for the next academic year.

-I accept the expectation that my child is committed to have lessons for the duration of the entire academic year.

-I understand that payment will be required in advance of each new term.

-I understand that should the payment deadline for the upcoming term be missed, my child will not be able to continue having music lessons for the remainder of the year.

-I understand that my child can only learn one instrument at school.

-I understand that should we choose not to continue with lessons at any point, we will not be refunded for the term already paid for and my child will be taken off the register for the rest of the year.

-I understand that the Music Service commit to offer 30 lessons across the academic year.

-I understand that Music Service teacher absences will be made up in extra weeks should they fall short of the 30-week minimum. Any refunds due will be issued at the end of the academic year.

-I accept that should my child miss lessons due to illness, trips, TED Days, strikes or unforeseen closures, there will be no refunds.

-I understand that my receipt of payment on ParentPay is confirmation of my child's place.

-I understand that lessons are held in small groups of children, lasting for 20-30 minutes.

-I understand that lessons take place during the normal school day (including breaks and lunchtimes). Please note that school lessons may be missed, and timings are non-negotiable. Lessons are scheduled by the music teachers themselves.

-I understand that all communication and enquiries will be between myself and the instrument teacher via the child's practice diary as well as via email (teacher emails will be shared in September).

-I understand that instruments will be loaned by Services for Education - Music Services free of charge. I will ensure that instruments and cases are clearly labelled with my child's name and class. I understand that the school cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to instruments or contents of cases, either privately owned or belonging to Services for Education - Music Services. All repairs and maintenance costs of Music Service instruments are covered by the Music Service. Any borrowed instrument is returned to school, in good condition, at the termination of this agreement.

-I shall encourage my son/daughter to undertake an appropriate amount of practice each week as directed by the instrument teacher and that he/she brings music, instrument and other materials to the lesson as required.

Dear Parents,

As a school on two sites we have been working on finding the best solution for arranging successful "Sports Days" for all our pupils.

We have been able to book **Harborne Cricket Club** so all pupils at Main site will go there for Sports afternoons in June.

Reception, and Years 1 and 2 at the Main Site will attend on **Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> June**.

Our Annex Junior classes (3S, 4GV and 5LM) will also join the KS2 Main Site classes at the KS2 Sports afternoon which this year will be on **Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> June.** 

Staff from both sites will walk the children to the cricket club (nearer the time we will ask for parent volunteers to join us).

We then expect many children will leave with their parents after the events but staff can walk children back to school for collection from their normal school site or to go to after school club if their parents request it.

Having risk assessed it, we do not think that the journey from The Annex to the Cricket Club is suitable for our younger children.

Therefore, the Annex EYFS/KS1 classes (RTD, 1M, 2P) will have their own Sports afternoon at the Annex on **Monday 24<sup>th</sup> June.** 

Moving forward this will be our plan so that the children on both sites benefit from a smaller event for their first three years in school but are part of a larger event as they get older and are able to enjoy participating with the entire year group. We look forward to welcoming parents to support their children at all three events and will provide more details nearer the time but thought you may welcome some advance warning of dates and locations.
