





Art and Design	<p>Painting – Koi Fish, Terry Gilecki (1954), a contemporary artist.</p> <p><i>How does Terry Gilecki use colour and movement in his artwork to make koi fish appear realistic and eye-catching?</i></p>
Music	<p>Dona Nobis Pacem – The phrase ‘Dona nobis pacem’ translates as ‘Grant us peace’.</p> <p>As well as being sung in churches, it has also been adopted for use as a song with a broader message about peace.</p> <p><i>What mood or feeling does the song ‘Dona Nobis Pacem’ create and how do the words and music work together to express peace?</i></p>
